

A more control on the information collection process from NGOs to create websites: 1NGO has come up with a very simple and easy to use google form for NGO to fill up details about their organisation. The form has 9-10 questions consisting of information about NGO program, goal, objective, tea members, etc. The form has helped our team to be more organized and focused on getting the right information. Other hand, NGOs know what type of data to be shared for website creation.

A similar form is shared after the website is created for collecting bank details of the NGO. This has helped the team to act fast and in a more organized manner. Data collection has become easier and faster.


Donation Page launched: HelpNGOs


Analytics attached to 1NGO dashboard:


DNA website going live:

The DNA website went live in the month of January,2022.




10. Team Members:
