ANNUAL REPORT 2016-17

Arunodaya People's Organisation for Integrated Rural Awareness and Development Action is a non-profitable organization. It is committed to the rural people's development especially women and children and youths.

It is registered under the Karnataka State Societies Registration Act 1960 with the objectives of taking up integrated rural and urban development programmes mainly education, health care. This organization is the brain child of Sr. Mary Mathew and Mr. V.P. Arahunashi.

**GOAL:**

"To organise and train the rural poor and to create and promote critical awareness on social consciousness about their health, education and socio-economic problems in the community and empower them for constructive and sustainable community development."

To achieve the goal we have set the following objectives;

**Education :**

Quality education for social change is the main theme. Education is the mother of all the development of the human being. The areas where we are involved need the tremendous task to achieve. People as a whole per capita income are below poverty line. Because of these factors parents are not able to educate their children effectively. They are not giving much importance to the education especially female children because of social evils like illiteracy, child

labour, child marriage , Devadasi system, exploitation of women in all the aspects myths and superstition practices were more prevalent.

To give better education and support to the poor students especially girls who are dropouts. We have encouraged continuing the education regular school in the area where they could continue till 10<sup>th</sup> standard.

During the April and May 2015 we had been organised the summer coaching class for high school students that is from 8<sup>th</sup> standard to 10<sup>th</sup> standard. In two months time we had given importance for to read, to write and to speak the languages properly because the language that may be Kannada or English or Hindi is basic for understanding all other subjects. When they improve in their hand writing they will be clear about their study. Along with this we had given concentration to Mathematics and Science subjects also.

During 2015-16 educational year began from 29.05.2015 with 40 new admissions to 1<sup>st</sup> standard and there were 500 students studied from Nursery to 10<sup>th</sup> class. We are happy to share with you that 8<sup>th</sup> batch of 10<sup>th</sup> standard students have passed out and scored 90% results in the annual examinations and they continued their education in Diploma engineering and some have continued in Pre university course in Arts and Science branches. We have organised special classes and meetings with the parents and communication and relationship enabled us to achieve a good result. Students also were given hostel facilities and supervised study.

Right To Education; (RTE)

Right to education which helped to the needy and underprivileged children. This programme has been introduced by the government in 2012-13 educational year. In this programme 25% of the 1<sup>st</sup> standard children will have the previllaged to get the financial support. Totally 63 children

have got this facility like school fees , educational materials and other expenditures but this is not sufficient to fulfil the requirements of the children. This is only small amount of help.

Bridge Of Humanity Germany:

After from the We have also privileged to give scholarship for another 63 students by the concern and generosity of the Bridge of Humanity from German especially for girl students. In this regard Mr&s Mrs Hildegard and Klaw are very much appreciated and remembered with thanks. Parents of these children are very much happy and enthusiastic to send their children to continue their education. This amount is utilised for the supplying the education materials and uniforms and school fees and family welfare activities and high school extension building at Vaddarahalli had been completed by the financial support of Bridge of Humanity. For cultural activities the Kalabhavan (Cultural activities) for the children.

SC & ST and Minority Welfare Department:

We have scholarship facility for SC/ST students from social welfare department and also for minorities. 30 minorities' children have profited by the scholarship. The available facilities are used well.

SPORTS Activities:

Our students have done very well in sports, games, karates, cultural programmes conducted in the Zonal and Taluka level. And they have received many prizes and certificates from education department in various games and sports conducted.

**KARATE:**

Karate is one of the physical as well as mental exercise. It helps the students to improve concentration in study and also improve their health and our students have won the prizes including national and international for karate. Since we have a well experience karate master with Don 7<sup>th</sup> with great zeal he had trained the students especially girls. Apart from this we do have all qualified teachers, who get regular trainings to scope up the demands of formal education to achieve effective quality education. Needless to say that there is a need of improvement in this regard.

Community participation is another aspect we keep in mind and so parents meetings are held regularly awareness education to the family personnel and family counselling are conducted. School committee meeting is conducted regularly to evaluate and make necessary changes for the betterment of the students and resource persons etc. Many well wishers are encouraged the activities of the school.

We have sufficient infrastructure, play ground, drinking water facility, toilets, garden and hostel etc. Our school Anniversary function was very well appreciated and happy.
