### ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2017-18

Arunodaya Peoples Organization For Integrated Rural Awareness And development Action is a registered non profit organization for the integrated rural development in Karnataka. It is registered under the Karnataka Societies registration Act 1960. It is with the objectives of integrated rural and urban development programme mainly education, health care activities for women and children and also youth of the area.

### AIM:

"To organise and train the rural poor to create and promote critical awareness on social consciousness about their health, education and socio-economic problems in the community and empower them for constructive and sustainable community development."

To achieve the Aim we have setup the following objectives.

Education: The educational year 2017-18 began with summer coaching classes for the rural children who are going to the higher classes. The course was organised during the summer time since the regular school was on holiday. Children will be free from the annul examination and also from mental tension. They and their parents had requested the management to conduct the specially class. They could learn spoken English. In the summer couching classes we use to teach English: reading, writing and speaking. The rural children are always behind due to lack of learning facilities and the system. Therefore the Arunodaya Poirada usally start the couching from 15.04.2016 to 25.5.2017. 40 days we teach them basic English and also other subjects like mathematics, Science and Social science. Hence the children will adjust with new environment in their new classes.

This year about 40 children from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10stds students have got the registration. April 14 is being Dr Ambedkar's birth day celebration. All children and staff used attend the programme. The classes were conducted morning 9.30 am to 3.00pm. The preference for the couching we give preference to students whose parents are daily coolies, mines coolies and agriculture labours. Due to financial problem many may discontinued specially the girl children education.

Social problems like illiteracy, child labour, child marriage, Devadasi system, exploitation, myths and superstition practices could be eradicate by giving awareness education to students and parents. So they will be happy to continue the education. By giving better education and support the poor students especially girls who are dropouts, we have encouraged to continue the education in local areas to  $10^{th}$  classes.

During 2017-18 there were 500 students studied from pre-primary and 1<sup>st</sup> class to 10<sup>th</sup> class. 28<sup>th</sup> May 2017 to 14<sup>th</sup> April 2018 was the education period. In the beginning New admission for the 2017-18 started from 1<sup>st</sup> std to all classes in our school.

10<sup>th</sup> batch of 10<sup>th</sup> class have scored 90% in Annual examinations. They continued the 11<sup>th</sup> standard in technical courses like ITI and Diploma and few in science too.

Right To Education: (RTE): The Government of India has introduced the RTE Act in India for providing the free education facilities to the poor students in private schools. According to the scheme 25% children have to be taken out of the total intake in 1<sup>st</sup> standard in last year. In 17-18 year 10 children were admitted to this scheme. Totally 70 students were given free education from 1<sup>st</sup> standard to 6<sup>th</sup> standard. Total no is 70.

BRIDGE OF HUMANITY Germany: Bridge of Humanity is one of the German based social development organisation which helps the poor children specially girls. This has been giving the scholarship for 63 poor students and during this year they have extended their support another 30 poor students who are studying in high school level. These children were given free education. (School fees, Uniforms and education materials and family welfare etc). They were encouraged from Government schools to Arunodaya St Mary's School. Those who have passed 8th class.

The Management, staff and the parents have a great regards to the Members of the Bridge Of Humanity especially Mrs Hildegard and Mrs Klaus Wansleben who are now retired from the service and Mrs Maria Krautzberger who has been serving in their place as President of the institution.

SHRIRAM FINANCIAL BANK SUPPORT: This is also one of the private financial sector pwhich gives financial support to the Mines Lorry Drives children who are residing in Bellary district. After mines work stopped they do not have the work. They become unemployed. Therefore this bank has helping since last three years. There are 30 students have got the financial support in our school. A small amount to support them.

Scholarship from the Government Welfare Department: The Government of Karnataka has some welfare department like Social Welfare, Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes. From these department many children who belongs to the scheduled caste and scheduled tribe families got the scholarship facility.

Competitive Examination: There are government running school for above 5<sup>th</sup> standard. These are Navodaya, Murarji Desai, Kasturba school and Sainik schools etc. Every year they organise the test for brilliant students. From our school few have got the admission in such schools. Apart from these examination Science test were conducted by the some private agencies and our school students have got the State, District and Taluka level prizes.

Karate Tournament: Karate is one of the physical education and it helps the integrated development of the child. Mr Riju M J is a Karate master. He teaches the Karate to school children specially girls students to protect themselves. They have grown by physically and also mentally. They are also good in study now. Many students have participated in Karate championship tournament and got the medals and certificates. It is appreciated by the people and development.

Boarding and Hostel facilities: Residential facility is made to the students who are coming to study in our school from faraway places. During this year 30

students were staying in the hostel. Apart from the regular beneficiary 30 SSLC students have got this facility. They were staying here from Januvary to April 10 for preparation for annual examination and the poor children are supported by the organization by getting small financial support.

**Teaching Staff:** During the educational year 2017-18, experienced and well qualified staff were appointed. They are Nursery Teacher Training course (NTC), Diploma in Education (D.Ed), Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Education (B.A.B.Ed), Master of Arts and Bachelor of Education, Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Education(B.Sc.B.Ed) and also Master of Science and Bachelor of Education (M.Sc B.Ed).



**Teachers Meetings And Training Programme**: To improve the teaching skill and the effectiveness of the teaching, teacher's meeting were conducted. During this year 04 teachers meeting and 02 training programmes were conducted and individual coaching has been provided by experienced person also.


# Community Participation In Education And Rural Development

# Adolescent Health Awareness Programme:

Adolescence are associated with teenage years and their physical, psychological and cultural expressions begins earlier at the age of 12<sup>th</sup> and ends with later at 18 years. Puberty is typically begins during this period especially among girls. By fast physical growth, many girl children will drop the scool and also learn many behavioural factors by their home and friends that may be good or bad attitudes. This will effect on the society. Therefore We have given importance to their personal hygiene and social, cultural development by arranging speeches by Doctors and Councillors and also by giving the moral education in the class room sessions and also arranged health checkups. With all these efforts girls are increasing in learning and continue the study. Parents are also aware of their children future as they are the back bone of the nation. 





